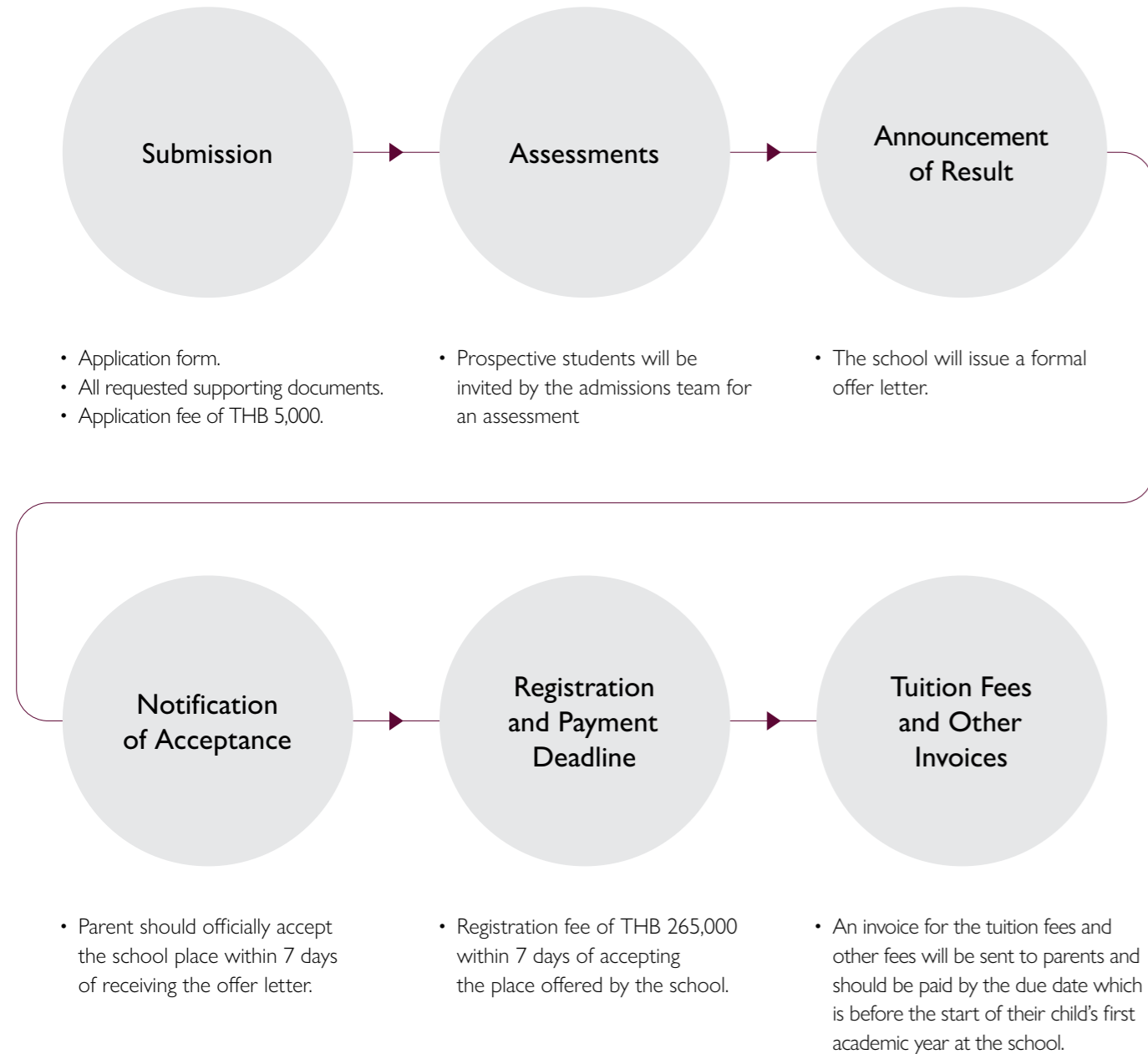


ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Academic Year 2026-2027



*For families who are applying from abroad or who are unable to visit the campus in person, we are able to offer online assessments for prospective students. We would like to facilitate the admissions process for families who have not yet been able to visit us in person and can provide these details upon request.

EARLY YEARS

Pre-Nursery (ages 2+ to 3 years) Nursery (ages 3+ to 4 years)

All students aged 2 to 4 begin their journey with us through the Early Years admissions route. Applications can be submitted directly through our website. Parents are asked to complete the application form in full and upload the requested documents. A non-refundable Application Fee of THB 5,000 is payable at the time of submission.

Reception (ages 4+ to 5 years)

All students aged 4 to 5 begin their journey with us through the Early Years admissions route. Applications can be submitted directly through our website. Parents are asked to complete the application form in full and upload the requested documents. A non-refundable Application Fee of THB 5,000 is payable at the time of submission.

Entry Process

Students will be invited to come to the school in small groups with their parents, where we will be able to see how they interact with adults and other students as they engage in play-based tasks. The atmosphere will be relaxed, with the focus on enjoyment of the activities, giving us the opportunity to get to know the students and understand how they are developing. Following this, parents will be invited to a short informal discussion about the school and their student.

(Total duration: approximately 1 hour)

Students will be invited to the school in small groups with their parents. These groups will either consist of other applicants or, where possible, be joined by current in-class students. During the session, we will observe how children interact with adults and peers while engaging in a mixture of play-based and early learning activities, including simple literacy and numeracy games. The atmosphere will be relaxed and focused on enjoyment, giving us the opportunity to get to know each student and understand how they are developing. Following this, parents will be invited to a short informal discussion about the school and their child.

(Total duration: approximately 1 hour)

JUNIOR SCHOOL

Year 1 (ages 5+ to 6 years) Year 2 (ages 6+ to 7 years)

All students aged 5 to 7 begin their journey with us through the Junior School admissions route. Applications can be submitted directly through our website. Parents are asked to complete the application form in full and upload the requested documents. A non-refundable Application Fee of THB 5,000 is payable at the time of submission.

Entry Process

Children will be assessed in small groups, giving us the chance to observe how they interact with adults and other students. Each child will then have an individual session with a member of the leadership team, where they will complete short age-appropriate tasks in reading, writing, and mathematics. There will also be a short informal chat with the student to help us understand their interests, confidence, and readiness for learning. The atmosphere will remain relaxed and supportive, with the focus on allowing children to feel comfortable and show their developing abilities. Following this, parents will be invited to a short informal discussion about the school and their child.

(Total duration: approximately 1.5 hours)

Supporting Documents

Applications should include a copy of your child's passport or birth certificate and a recent photograph, upload application form. Any additional information – such as medical needs, allergies, or learning support requirements – must be shared by the day of assessment so that we can provide the best possible support for your child. Applications must also include a minimum of the last two terms of school reports, translated into English where necessary.

If the year group is at capacity, families may be offered a spot on the Waitlist, confirmed with a fee of THB 10,000 to secure priority for the next available place. The fee will be refunded if the student is enrolled at a later date.

Year 3 (ages 7+ to 8 years) Year 4 (ages 8+ to 9 years) Year 5 (ages 9+ to 10 years) Year 6 (ages 10+ to 11 years)

All students aged 7 to 11 begin their journey with us through the Junior School admissions route. Applications can be submitted directly through our website. Parents are asked to complete the application form in full and upload the requested documents. A non-refundable Application Fee of THB 5,000 is payable at the time of submission.

Students will be assessed in small groups, either with other applicants or as part of a class activity, giving us the opportunity to observe how they interact with adults and other students. Each student will also complete short written assessments in English and Mathematics, sit an online cognitive aptitude test (CAT4), and have an individual interview with a member of the leadership team. The atmosphere will be calm and supportive, ensuring that students feel comfortable and able to demonstrate their abilities with confidence.

(Total duration: approximately 3 hours, including breaks)
